Dear Sierra Madre Resident,

The City of Sierra Madre is conducting an architectural survey in July and August 2025 throughout the City as part of documenting the impacts of this past winter's wildfires.

National Park Service staff will conduct the survey to identify, document, and evaluate the community's historic resources. This information is important for:

- Understanding the community's architectural character and history
- Guiding future development and preservation efforts
- Potentially listing properties in the National Register of Historic Places

Qualified National Park Service employees will take photographs of and make notes on distinctive architectural features of each property and expect to spend approximately 5 minutes at each site. National Park Service staff will be clearly identified with orange safety vests and identification; they **will not** enter homes or buildings, and all work will be performed from the public right of way. The focus of the survey will be to document properties from the exterior.
