I have reviewed the staff report for the Noise Ordinance Amendment and would like to provide the following thoughts for consideration at the meeting:

1. I agree with the Planning Commission that the new definition of “Sound truck” is unnecessary; it could end up causing problems in the future. This is not a problem we encounter frequently and could conflict with potential uses for parades or other civic events.
2. I recommend that a discussion about leaf blowers be postponed and considered as a separate agenda item. I recommend that the analysis include a discussion air pollution impacts of changing from gas to electric leaf blowers.
